S-270: Basic Air Operations

This course covers aircraft types and capabilities, aviation management and safety, tactical and logistical uses of aircraft, and requirements for helicopter take-off and landing areas. This course is designed for individuals responsible for incident communications.

CISM: Individual Crisis Intervention and Peer Support

This program is designed to teach participants the fundamentals of, and specific protocol for, individual crisis intervention. S-234: Ignition Operations - All Risk
